Cohort Overview

A structured, 4-week cohort-based program designed to support participants in gaining financial literacy and maximizing benefits and tax credits. Participate in weekly seminars (1.5 /hours /week). Receive one-on-one advising and support. \$100 Honoraria & Accommodation support.

Who should sign up?

FEEWI offers Black-focused, culturally affirming advising and support for:

- Black people (African Canadian, Afro-Caribbean, Afro-Latino, Afro-Indigenous, African American, or mixed-race of African descent)
- Black people with disabilities (diagnosed, undiagnosed, or self-diagnosed)
- Parents, partners, caregivers, and guardians of Black children, adults, or seniors with disabilities

- Federal disability credits, benefits, and retro-payment for up to 10 years.
- Debt management, financial coach, and investment options


FEEWI goes beyond workshops — we help you take real action.
